Each physician assistant student must have access to a Windows-based or Apple-based laptop computer which they are responsible to maintain. Each student should ensure that their computing device(s) meets the minimum standards listed below. We do NOT recommend the use of Chromebooks as a primary computing device.

The following is a description of suggested computer hardware, software and data communication requirements. Please familiarize yourself with these requirements to assure that your laptop computer fully meets them.

A computer purchased within the last 2 years will generally meet the minimum computer hardware requirements.
