Welcome once again to the School of Health Professions!

As a new School of Health Professions (SHP) student, you are required to attend our orientation Monday, June 3, 2024. A great deal of very important information will be covered. The SHP orientation on June 3rd begins promptly at 10:00 a.m. and will run until 1:30 p.m. Lunch will be provided. You should plan to arrive at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, June 3, 2024.

Location: Student Activities Center, West Campus

Parking: Lot 13 is available for you to use on this day, only. Please visit this parking map for further information. The lot can be seen in cell 4B:

You will be allowed to utilize any Faculty/Staff Section spot in the lot. You are not permitted to park in the metered area in the back corner of the lot. Meters, ADA, Fire Zone, etc. will still be enforced by parking enforcement.

You will also be required to participate in a separate program specific orientation. In addition, some programs will be hosting their students in advance, to prepare for their summer anatomy course. Be sure to check your email often for updates directly from your program.

On or around May 15, 2024, you will be given access to our SHP Community Page in Brightspace. An orientation onboarding checklist, as well as information about the valuable resources at Stony Brook, will be found there.

Please note that any other communication you may receive from Stony Brook regarding orientation programs may refer to the west campus summer orientation, which is not for Health Professions students. To avoid confusion, discard it. Our orientation requires no reservation.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

The complete student health history and physical examination report forms must be submitted at least two weeks prior to your program start date. We want to be sure the date of your history and physical examination is close to your program start date so that it can carry you through your first year in the program. You must upload the completed SHP Health Form with relevant lab reports with quantitative results to the following:

- 1. Stony Brook University Student Health Service https://stonybrook.medicatconnect.com
 - You will log-in with your NetID and password (maintenance for NetID can be found in SOLAR)
- 2. CASTLEBRANCH (instructions and optional training to follow in a separate email)

Please remember that all completed health forms with attached laboratory quantitative results must be received at least two weeks prior to the start of your program. All students must pay for the Health Tracker in Castlebranch. Some students may also be required to complete the Criminal Background Check and/or Toxicology tests in Castlebranch. Your program will give you specific instructions about the Criminal Background Check and/or Toxicology requirements.

Conditions of Admission: Documentation of outstanding conditions of admission must also be received prior to the start of classes.

Housing: For the most up to date information regarding on-campus housing please reference this link http://studentaffairs.stonybrook.edu/res/. We do recommend that you request the West Apartments (quiet lifestyle) when you complete the on-line preference form. Stony Brook

"crossover" students will need to specify **New HSC Admit** on the Housing application. Southampton location students will receive specific housing information via email from Campus Residences. For additional residence hall and apartment information, please email me at joanmarie.schreiber@stonybrook.edu. Housing deposits and housing applications have specific deadlines for submission. Undergraduate deposits are due May 1 and Graduate student housing deposits are due May 15.

Financial Aid: If you are interested in applying for summer 2024 financial aid, you must be enrolled in summer classes to be able to apply for summer aid. For financial information, consult the Office of Financial Aid website at https://www.stonybrook.edu/commcms/finaid/ or call (631) 632-6840. During the years that you are a student here in the School of Health Professions, you will be billed each summer, fall, and spring term as it relates to your program registration. Students in Applied Health Informatics, Athletic Training, Clinical Laboratory Sciences, Occupational Therapy, Physician Assistant, Speech-Language Pathology, and Respiratory Care programs will also be charged tuition and fees for the 2024 summer term. Some students will also be billed for summer 2024 and 2024, since their program's curricula include required summer clinical and didactic courses at
